- ❖ All students must fill out a Registration/Permission Form. Ticket price includes a mocktail hour, dinner, live band, and dance lessons in the weeks leading up to the event. Formal invitation to follow.
  - ❖ If you are paying for another GHNO student as your guest, please **include his/her Registration/Permission Form with your own.** Payment must be made on Configio for both tickets.
  - ❖ If your guest is from **outside GHNO**, (*a high school student* in 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> **fill out the boxed section** (“Guest Registration”), **provide a photocopy of a picture ID with this form,** and **make your own payment for both tickets on Configio.**

## Great Hearts Northern Oaks 2025 Promenade Ball Policies and Dress Code

### A NOTE ON THE THEME

The Prom Committee at Great Hearts Northern Oaks theme is TBD. Students are encouraged to be creative in incorporating the theme into their personal dress for the evening. The theme is predominately for decoration purposes.

### REGISTRATION & ATTENDANCE PROTOCOL

- 1) All students planning to attend must turn in a completed Student Registration Form along with the fee for their tickets. Tickets are payable **only in advance** (not at the door) and are **non-refundable**.
- 2) Any GHNO senior or junior student may attend. Sophomores may attend if invited as guests.
- 3) Non-GHNO guests may be invited as long as they are a *high school student* in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, and must have the information required on the Guest Registration section of the GHNO Student Registration/Permission Form, and provide a copy of their student ID or driver's license along with permission form. Non-GHNO students also are required to follow the dress code. (deadlines for ticket purchase and forms are the same)
- 4) This is a **closed event** – no student or guest will be allowed to leave and then return. Students must arrive at the prom no later than 6:00 PM, and they may not leave until it is over at 10:30 PM. Doors will be open as early as 5:30.

### DRESS CODE

#### **Gentlemen:**

- A formal tuxedo – i.e., “black tie attire” – is encouraged; dark suits are acceptable.
- No colored tuxedos or suits are allowed.
- Neckties or bowties are required.
- Ties, vests, or cummerbunds may be colored.
- Dress shoes are required and must remain on the feet the entire evening.
- The GHNO Student Handbook rules regarding hair, jewelry, and any other details not mentioned above still apply.

#### **Ladies:**

- Tea-length (mid-calf) or full-length gowns are required.
- In front, gowns may be no lower than four closed-fingers below the collarbone; in back, gown must come up to the bottom of shoulder blades.\*
- Midriffs or backs below the bottom of the shoulder blades must be covered. Sheer fabric is not sufficient. \*\*
- Slits are permissible and must be no higher than 2 inches above the knee.
- Dress shoes are required.
- The GHNO Student Handbook rules regarding hair still apply.
- Ladies may wear a nail polish color of their choice to the prom provided that when they return to school on Monday their nails follow handbook guidelines.

#### **Note For Woman's Dress code:**

\* Thin-strap, spaghetti-strap, and strapless gowns are permitted; however, gowns should not be ‘revealing’ or low-cut.

\*\* Sheer or holes may be reinforced with other material.

### ETIQUETTE

- 1) Keep displays of affection to a tasteful minimum; remember you are part of a larger group. Kissing is not permitted.
- 2) Gentlemen may purchase a corsage for their dates; ladies may purchase a boutonniere for their dates.
- 3) Be present at the evening's activities. While cell phones may be within the student's possession, the phone should not be out or used.

### DISCIPLINARY ISSUES

In the unlikely case a student commits a violation in the above areas, s/he will be asked to leave the event immediately and parents will be notified.

## **DANCE LESSONS**

As GHNO students, Juniors and Seniors have had the opportunity to learn to dance. However, especially if we have guests that are coming from other schools, it is important to brush up! Students should plan to attend two of the dance sessions. Please plan to bring your guests from other schools. (We will be dancing swing and waltz, and possibly more.)
